

# U.S. Tariff Monthly Report — February 2026

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**February in one line:** 12 relevant notices tracked. The storyline of the month: the "Ending Certain Tariff Actions" proclamation (Feb 25) — coinciding with the Feb 24 wind-down of IEEPA-related tariff actions — and a second proclamation continuing the suspension of duty-free de minimis treatment for all countries, keeping the \$800 exemption off the table ahead of June's indefinite suspension.
